



# NEVER Drink and Drive Not Even Once

## **An Important Reminder from the CWA PEIR and Joint Safety Committees**

Colorado State law prohibits a person from driving while under the influence of alcohol or drugs or while the person's ability to drive is impaired by alcohol or drugs.

### **Did You Know?**

- A person is presumed to be DUI (driving under the influence) if the test shows a blood alcohol level of at least 0.08.
- A person's first DUI violation leads to a license suspension of 9 months to two years AND 12 points.
- A person's first DUI offense leads to a minimum mandatory 5 days – 1 year of jail time, \$600-\$1000 in fines, and 48-96 hours of public service.
- Penalties for a DWAI with a blood alcohol content of .08 to as low as .02 can include mandatory jail time, license suspension, fines, classes, community service and eight points!!
- Persons who violate the state's drunk driving laws may have to pay court costs, penalty surcharges of up to \$500 to help pay for programs to address persistent drunk drivers, surcharges to benefit the crime victim compensation fund, fees to reinstate a driver's license after suspension or revocation, and other fees, charges and penalties.
